There are some who view a host of claimed negative social ills allegedly related to the large size of firms like Amazon as an occasion to <u>call for the company's break up</u>. And, unfortunately, these critics find an unlikely ally in President Trump, whose <u>tweet storms</u> claim that tech platforms are too big and extract unfair rents at the expense of small businesses. But these critics are wrong: Amazon is not a dangerous monopoly, and it certainly should not be broken up.
